

Bi-Folkal kits are program resources designed to encourage memory on a particular time or topic.

The following “Remembering” Kits are available through the adult outreach program:

1. **1924:** Explore the styles, food, booze, music, sports heroes and other fads for this era.
2. **African American Lives:** *Highlights of African American contributions and accomplishments for all ages and cultures.
3. **Automobiles:** Rev up memories of first cars, learning to drive and road trips.
4. **Birthdays:** Celebrate the tears, laughter, joy and sadness that comes with each birthday. This is an excellent kit to add a positive perspective on aging.
5. **County Fair:** Ice cream, lemonade, blue ribbons...
6. **Depression:** Celebrate the everyday heroes who survived this era and create a survival handbook for tomorrow.
7. **Fall:** Enjoy memories of fall, farms and getting ready for winter.
8. **Farm Days:** Morning chores, wash day, cowbells, seeds...who could resist remembering this type of life.
9. **Fashion:** *Remember that special outfit for the special occasion and explore how fashion has changed for men and women.
10. **Fifties:** Rock and Roll, television, Tupperware parties, movie stars, slinky and Elvis!
11. **Fun and Games:** A great vehicle to encourage socializing, learning and fun.
12. **Home Front:** *Share and compare experiences from WWII or any war.
13. **Music:** *Define and appreciate generations through music.
14. **Pets:** *Music, kits, pictures and readings are designed to prompt discussions about pets for pet owners and animal lovers.
15. **School Days:** *Favorite memories of one-room school house, city high schools, marbles, jacks and other school tools.
16. **Spring:** Great for the Easter season. Celebrate colors, new life, weather and hope.

17. **Summertime:** Conjure memories of vacations, home remedies, screen door slamming and don't forget the lemonade.
18. **Train Rides:** Get on board and enjoy music, sounds, and interviews about train rides.
19. **Work Life:** Honor the seniors whose professions built our roads and bridges. Explore stories of work done from home or on a farm and compare it to the workforce of today.
